The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Shri Ashok Gehlot, launched R-CAT Jaipur on 20th August 2022.

## R-CAT & Red Hat

R-CAT has also launched training and certification courses from Red Hat and the first batch in 'Red Hat Certified System Administrator' is scheduled for September 2022. This course will help attain a solid foundation in Linux System Administration and ensure improved ability to manage IT infrastructure efficiently. This will take the learner from minimal Linux experience to being a fully capable Linux administrator. He/she will also go through a boot camp to prepare for the Red Hat Performance Based Certification Exam.

## Eligibility

- 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> year Engineering student or BCA/MCA final year student in Rajasthan
- Aggregate %age in previous years of Graduation must be 70% or above
- Student should be from Rajasthan and have a valid Jan Aadhaar card

## Documents Required

1. Jan Aadhaar Card
2. ID Card (any 1): Aadhaar / Driving License / Voter ID.
3. Address Proof
4. 10<sup>th</sup> Certificate
5. 12<sup>th</sup> Certificate
6. College ID Card
7. Proof of degree pursuance (previous semester marksheet)



## Admission Process:

**Registration:** Duly filled in registration form, with requisite documents, can be submitted online on <https://rcat.rajasthan.gov.in/> or offline to the Red Hat contact person at R-CAT

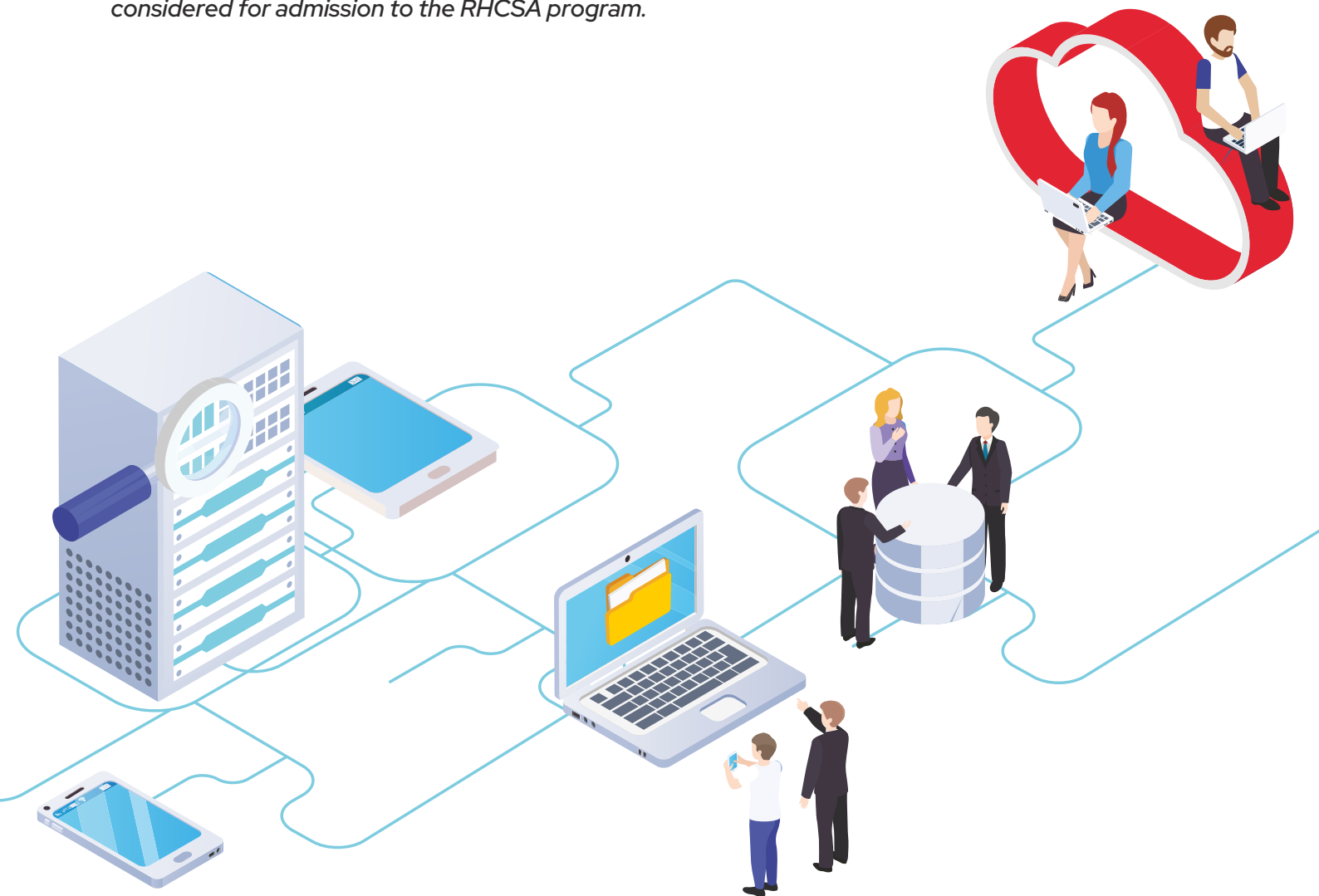
**Entrance Test:** 60 mins test covering questions on aptitude, numerical ability, logical reasoning, computer fundamentals, etc.

**Interaction:** Subsequent interaction with the Government & Red Hat team at R-CAT

**Result Declaration:** The result will be announced within 3 days of conduct of interaction. The waitlisted candidate will be able to join if somebody in the main list fails to join or drops out from the program.

**Fees:** The first batch will be fully sponsored by the Government of Rajasthan.

*Note: As a special gesture, the Government of Rajasthan has agreed to consider students registered for 'Red Hat IT Aptitude Test, India 2021', and meeting the above eligibility criteria, to be considered for admission to the RHCSA program.*
